Sustainable Sierra Communities Program: The Sierra Nevada Alliance is a non-profit organization and a network of over 85 conservation groups in the Sierra Nevada working to protect and restore Sierra land, water, wildlife and rural communities for future generations. The Sustainable Sierra Communities Program works to foster and support local actions and planning that establish building blocks for more resilient, thriving Sierra communities. Through on-the-ground projects, innovative programs, publications, workshops, and trainings, we empower local action for a sustainable future.

Job Description: This is a one-year AmeriCorps VISTA position (04/20/2012 thru 04/19/2013) that will work with the Sustainable Sierra Communities Program at the Sierra Nevada Alliance to develop a pilot outreach and education program that focuses on energy efficiency and water conservation for low income residents in El Dorado County. The goal of this program is to help residents save money, while saving energy, reducing green house gas emissions and living more sustainably. In addition to this local program, the member will also work with Alliance staff to create a regional program that encourages sustainable homes & gardens in the Sierra through on-the-ground projects and outreach efforts in Sierra communities. This position is managed by the Associate Director. The Sierra Nevada Alliance is a fun work environment that offers excellent networking and learning opportunities with other non-profit conservation groups and agencies in the Sierra Nevada region, a 400-mile long mountain range in Central and Northern California. This position is based at the Alliance office in South Lake Tahoe, California.

AmeriCorps VISTA members build capacity in nonprofit organizations and communities to help bring individuals and communities out of poverty.

Desired Qualifications:

- B.S./B.A. in environmental sciences/studies, communications or a related field.
- Knowledge, training and/or a good understanding of residential energy efficiency, renewable energy, urban water conservation, building performance and sustainable building practices.
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
- Experience creating outreach materials, planning events and coordinating volunteers.
- Strong interest or experience working with diverse groups, particularly low income populations.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and work independently.
- Familiarity with personal computer applications including Microsoft Office.

- Spanish language speaking and writing skills are preferred, but not required.
- Valid driver's license, ability to lift 25 pounds and work at a computer up to 6 hours a day.
- A passion for the Sierra, it's environmental issues and the grassroots movements working to protect and restore the "Range of Light".

Salary and benefits:

Salary and benefits are according to AmeriCorps VISTA compensation rates

- \$932/month stipend.
- Health care benefits.
- \$5,350 education award with completion of service.
- Reimbursement available for relocation to South Lake Tahoe, California.
- Support from Alliance staff during the transition and/or move.
